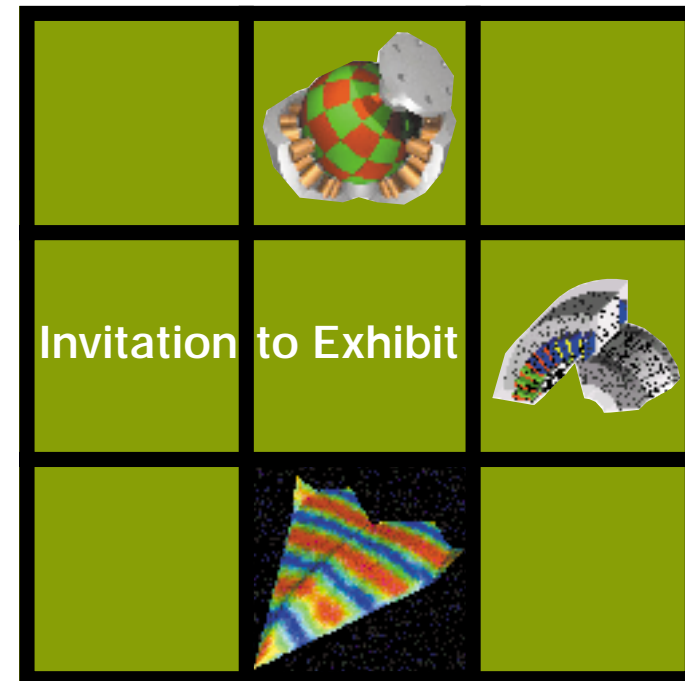
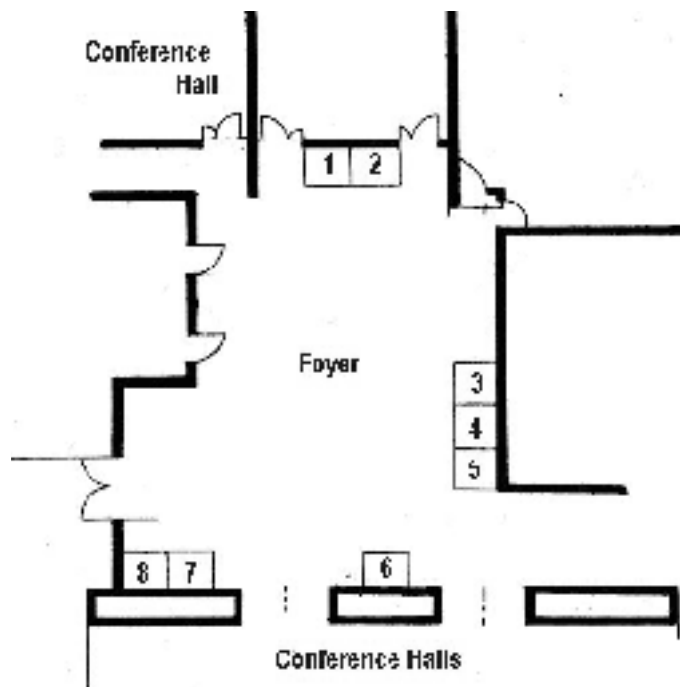
Venue
